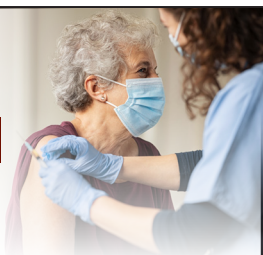

Letter from the Administrator

Hello all,

I'm writing with good news! I'm happy to say that we are officially out of outbreak. On top of that, we have now met requirements to allow indoor visitation. Obviously, we must remain diligent in ensuring our residents and staffs safety when it comes to COVID-19, so our indoor visitation does come with certain guidances from the CDC and CMS (Centers for Medicare/Medicaid Services).

Unfortunately, that means at any given moment we would have to suspend indoor visitation. Requirements to allow indoor visits:

1. Our facility cannot be in outbreak status.
2. Walworth County positivity rate must be below 10%.
3. We are allowing visits 7 days a week.
4. An appointment is required. All visits will require an appointment that is made ahead of time. The last appointment time for the day is 4pm.
5. If you want to have a visit on Saturday or Sunday, you must call by Friday at 4pm. This will ensure that staff are aware of your visit. If you arrive on a Saturday or Sunday without making an appointment ahead of time, you will not be allowed entry.
6. We are only allowed a certain number of visitors inside the facility at any given time. To allow all residents the opportunity to have a visitor, visits will be limited to 30 minutes.
7. Residents are allowed a maximum of 2 visitors at a time.
8. All visitors must sign in and be screened for COVID-19 upon entry into the building. If you have symptoms you will not be allowed to visit. With that being said, please do not come to our facility to visit if you are sick.
9. Visitors must wear a mask at all times.
10. Visitors must maintain 6ft of distance during their visit.
11. Doors to resident rooms should remain open during visitation to allow for monitoring of mask use and social distancing.
12. Visitors are not allowed anywhere within the facility except where the visit is taking place.
13. Some visitors may have been fully vaccinated at this point. All the above rules will still apply to those individuals. We have not been given an updated guidance regarding vaccinated visitors.

I know this seems like a lot. I wish it were as simple as just opening up our doors and welcoming visitors back. However, we still have a community with COVID-19, so we still have to protect our vulnerable population at Holton. Thank you all for your cooperation. I know it's been a long frustrating road.
